A student earning a Bachelor of Music Education instrumental music degree will have completed the requirements to be eligible to apply for teacher licensure in instrumental music as issued by the Arkansas State Department of Education.

Students must earn a C or higher in all courses on the degree plan. Students must maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA or better. GPA is tracked throughout the program and verified for admission into internship.
